

What is a genocide?

A genocide is the deliberate and systematic extermination of a natural, national, political or cultural group.

ROLES

In a genocide there are four types of people:

- The victim → is who suffer the genocide, almost everybody were exterminated.
- The perpetrator → they are the aggressors, the killers.
- The bystander → the person who watches all the aggressions but don't do anything.
- The rescuer → he sees the aggressions and tries to help the victims.

Symbolization

This is the second step and it's a visual manifestation of hatred. For example Jews were forced to wear a yellow star in Nazi's occupation.

How can we stop it?


We think that we need a full political empowerment and citizenship rights for all the groups in the society.

Dehumanization

Polarisation

This is the sixth step, murders use propaganda like newspapers, radio or TV to spread messages of hate against the victims. An example is the newspaper called "La Libre Parole" who made this.



How can we stop it?

The most important thing is security protections for moderate leaders. Assistance to human rights groups. Assets of extremists must be seized.



Preparation

This is the seventh step of the genocide. victims are separated out and forced to live, for example, in ghettos.




How can we stop it?

Denial

This is the tenth and last step of the genocide. Perpetrators deny any crime.



HOW CAN WE STOP IT?

Perpetrators will deny that they committed any crimes. Yet, an international tribunal and national courts must punish perpetrators. They must be brought to justice.
